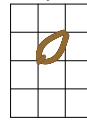

Fifteen (or thirty) minutes later, the nightly news is blaring on the t.v., and the cat has decided you make a pretty nice pillow.

Don't feel badly, you deserve a break now and then. So to reserve your seat for the next snooze, whip up this design before your eyes get too heavy, and slip it into a tuck-in pillow from your favorite needlework shop. Happy napping!

Plant hanger is three "extended" lazy daisy stitches. After you make the loop, bring the needle up near the green leaves and catch the loop there. Then come back up at the top of the hanger and start another lazy daisy in the same fashion; repeat one more time.
